Tuesday 13th December 2016 7.30pm Top Room, Charing Parish Hall

- 1. In attendance: Borough Cllr G Clarkson Cllrs Chair J Leyland; vice chair C Bain-Smith: T Reed: S Hawkins: S Crawley: N Blunt: H Billot: C Prinn: A Gudge & the clerk.
- 2. Declaration of Interest; H Billot re item 7.3 A Gudge re item 7.1
- Ten minute public discussion and question time. No one present. 3.
- 4. Six minute Borough Councillor question time: Borough Cllr Clarkson focussed on the proposed Wheler/Gladman application. He explained that due to the housing shortage in the country A.B.C have to plan for a noticeable increase in housing and new population projections mean this has to be higher than in the draft local plan. Charing has taken development over the last few years and will have to take more within the next five years. However he did not believe that this meant that all sites should be considered irrespective of whether they were suitable or not. There are number difficulties with the Gladman proposals. A.B.C has a duty to consider all planning applications. Orbit may not be an exception site when the new planning application is received.

- 5.1 16/01750/AS Agricultural building 450 metres south east of Newland Stud, **Newlands Road Charing:** Prior approval for the change of use two agricultural buildings and land within their curtilage to 2 residential dwelling's and associated operational development for Mr D Boyd(unanimous)(recommend support)
- 5.2 16/01695/AS West Leacon Farm. Leacon Lane Charing: resubmission of permission granted under 16/00923/AS (first floor extension with canopy. Extension to ground floor) to enlarge roof space for Mr R Parsons(unanimous)recommend support)
- 16/01774/AS 8 Sayer Road Charing: Division of existing property site to provide 5.3 adjacent detached dwelling for Mrs A Brewins (unanimous)(recommend support)

- 16/01513/AS Banavie Burleigh Road Charing: Proposed ground floor rear 6.1 extension involving the removal of existing extension for Mr & Mrs P Kent(granted)*
