	resolved. The main sewer from Cleardowns runs through Poppy fields Charing Green and to					
	Surgery. Southern Water will not adopt two other drains that go into the main drain; these					
	will be the responsibility of the residents. Proper agreements; i.e. approved by ABC ,were not					
	made at the tome with the developer and Southern Water. The pipes were laid very close to					
	the surface water drainage which could cause a risk of damage and cross contamination
