(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2024

Openreach works.

To allow gully works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Egerton Road, Charing.

A closure is planned from 10th August 2024, with estimated completion by 11th August 2024, between the hours of 08.00 and 16.00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC008WFGC7T7XA-03 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Egerton Road will be closed between the junction with Vicarage Lane and the junction with Lodge Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while gully works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Church Hill, Lenham Heath Road, Lenham Forstal Road, Forstal Road, Ashford Road, A20 Maidstone Road, Charing Heath Road, Tile Lodge Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
